

DIY CAMPING INFO

EXCITING NEW CHANGES TO SPECTATOR CAMPING!!

Bring your mates, your camping gear and move on in for 4 days of extreme horsepower partying to experience the best of Summernats.

There are now two spectator DIY camping areas: "Small Block" and "Big Block"

'Small block' is now available to tents, small camper trailers, cars and utes.

'Big Block' is now available to tents, large camper trailers, cars, utes, caravans and motorhomes.

WHO CAN CAMP?

Anyone with a Summernats Season Pass and the accompanying Camping Pass. Each person camping at Summernats must have (1) a Season Pass and (2) a Camping pass.

Campsites can be purchased by anyone with a Season Pass – these include Season or Platinum Passes.

Anyone aged 16 and under camping at Summernats, MUST be accompanied by a responsible adult at all times.

HOW IS DIY CAMPING SOLD?

1. There are two areas within the venue to choose from, 'Small Block' and 'Big Block'.
2. DIY Campsites are sold on a per site basis by a small site fee determined by camping area and inclusions.
3. Each person camping must have (1) a Season Pass and (2) a Camping pass.
4. You can purchase your own campsite or share with your mates.
5. All sites are allocated as next best available and are limited.
6. Anyone who has not pre-purchase a site or doesn't have a campsite to share, will be required to purchase a site upon check in and may be placed anywhere where space is available.

HOW DO I PURCHASE CAMPING?

1. Select 'Buy Tickets'
2. Select the 'Platinum or Season Passes' option. Camping will be at bottom of page.
3. Select Camp Site Type – 'Small Block' or 'Big Block'
4. Select Camping Pass – if not already purchased
5. Select additional items eg parking and any additional camping wristbands
6. Proceed through to check out.
7. Tickets will be emailed to you

HOW MUCH DOES A DIY CAMPSITE COST?

'Small Block' - \$50

- Available to tents, small camper trailers, cars and utes.
- 24sqm Space (6m x 4m) exact site configuration may vary by 10%.
- Access to power
- One vehicle per site
- Close proximity to Toilet and Shower facilities
- If the vehicle/set up is larger than 6m x 4m site, you may need to purchase additional campsites.

'Big Block' - \$60

- Available to tents, large camper trailers, cars, utes, caravans and motorhomes.
- 36sqm Space (6m x 6m) exact site configuration may vary by 10%.
- One vehicle per site
- Close proximity to Toilet and Shower facilities
- If the vehicle/set up is larger than 6m x 6m site, you may need to purchase additional campsites.

Note: All spectator ticket pricing include a \$3.00 booking fee per ticket.

HOW DO I CAMP WITH MY MATES?

You can purchase a campsite on your own or you can share a campsite with your mates. We recommend 4 persons maximum to one site, however, you can have as many people camp on your campsite as you wish provided all campers and your camping gear fit within your allocated boundary.

CAN I HAVE MY VEHICLE ON MY CAMPSITE?

All campsites include one vehicle per site to remain on your campsite for the duration of the event at no extra cost to you.

Any extra vehicles are required to park in the general public parking areas for a small fee. Pre- paid, multi day parking passes are available through online ticketing or you can pay for parking on the day of arrival.

Vehicles are defined as anything that has an engine and can drive.

You cannot move your vehicle for the duration of your stay – if you leave, then your vehicle cannot return.

I'VE ALREADY BOUGHT A SEASON PASS AND NOW I WANT TO CAMP

Camping passes are available for purchase separately to your Season pass. You can purchase your own campsite or share with your mates. Sharing with your mates requires one person to purchase the campsite and everyone else requires a Season pass and a Camping pass per person to camp on that campsite.

DO CAMPING PASSES INCLUDE ENTRY INTO THE EVENT?

No, a camping pass does not include entry into the event and are required in addition to a Season pass to be able to camp.

CAMPING TIMES

Check in Thursday 2/1/2020 11AM

Check out Sunday 5/1/2020 5PM

Camping is NOT available at any other time

CAMPING ACCESS

Collect your wristbands from Ticket Boxes at Gate 7 and then proceed to enter the event from gate 7B, camping check in.

PERMITTED ITEMS

- Tent and bedding
- Gas BBQ with approved gas bottles
- Eskies for food storage
- All camping equipment must remain on your campsite within your boundary
- There is a Supermarket on site for all those essentials you have forgotten to bring or need.

WHAT NOT TO BRING?

- Alcohol (ALL VEHICLES WILL BE SEARCHED)
- Fuel (NO STORAGE FACILITIES AVAILABLE)
- Glass Bottles
- Motorcycles
- Animals
- Fireworks
- Weapons
- Pools and Spas
- Drones
- Motorised scooters, eskies, skateboards or any unauthorised

vehicles

- Any other item prohibited as per the terms and conditions of entry.

Please **DO NOT** bring Kettles, Toasters, fridges over the size 180L and any furniture you are not willing to take home with you.

You must submit to a search of your car each time you enter Exhibition Park. Any alcohol, or other prohibited items found will be confiscated and not returned.
